**Are you writing, or on the verge of writing, your PhD thesis?  
Not sure what to do next?**

The Doctoral internship Program (DIP) offers McGill's doctoral students, at the end of their degree, the opportunity to learn and grow outside of academia through remunerated internships.

- ❖ Students may receive up to \$2,000 per month
- ❖ Funding will be provided for a period of 1 to 3 consecutive months
- ❖ For students enrolled full-time in PhD 6 or earlier who have submitted their initial thesis, but have not yet defended it.
- ❖ Internships available worldwide
